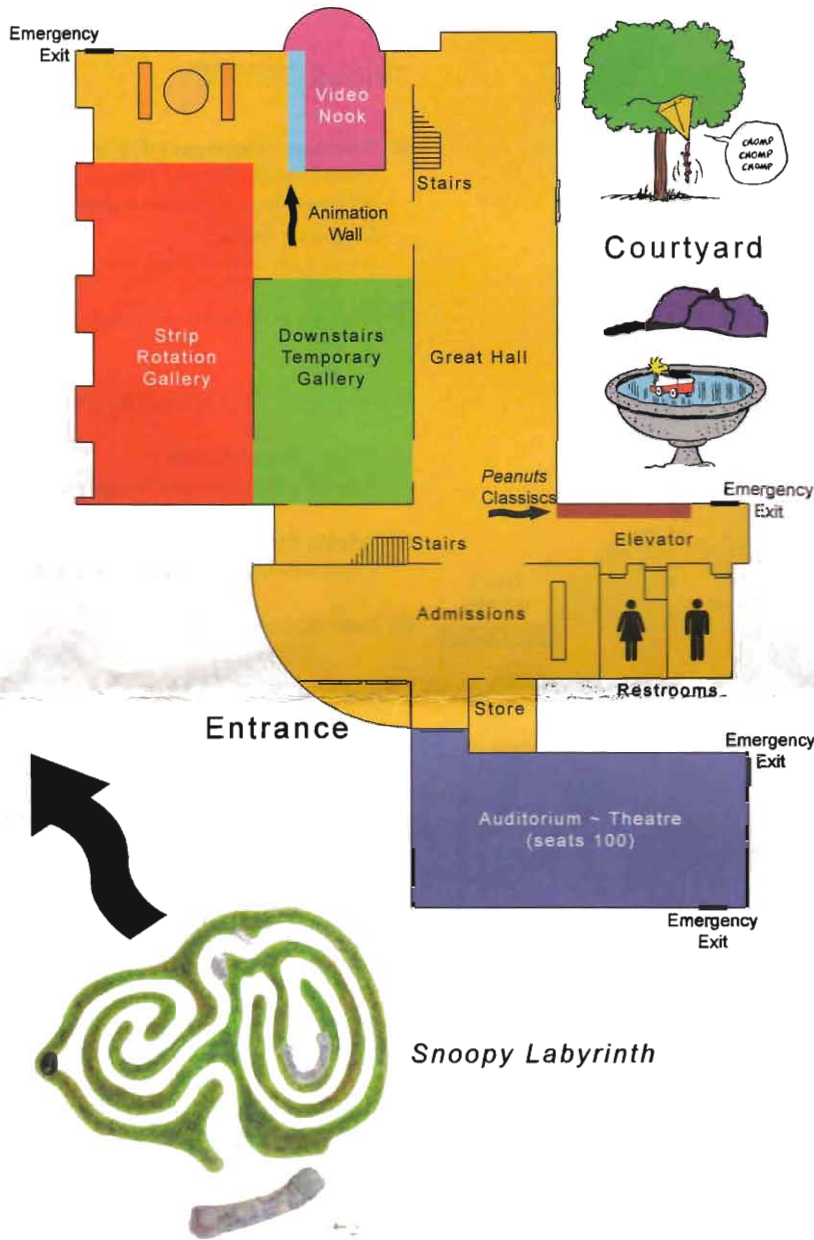

Great Hall

Morphing Snoopy has relief wood sculpture and ceramic tile mural by Yoshi Otani.

Auditorium ~ Theatre

Programs, documentaries, and cartoons - schedule posted outside Theatre doors.

Courtyard

Kite-eating tree, birdbath with holograms, shimmering drinking fountains, and other outdoor exhibits.

THINGS TO DO

Walk the *Snoopy Labyrinth* - the symbolic design has a single path leading to the center and back out again.

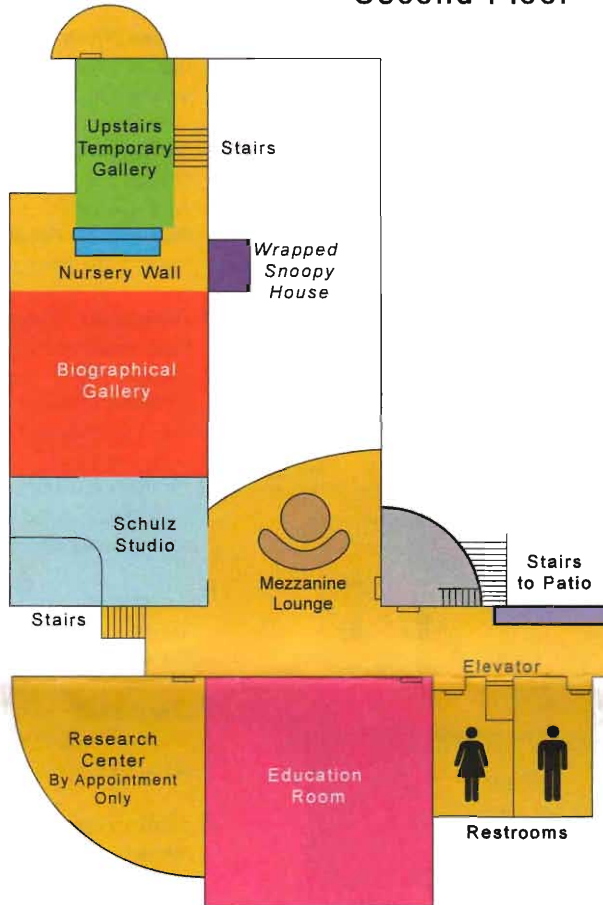

THINGS TO LEARN

- The exhibition *From Krazy Kat to Snoopy* illustrates how the work of early cartoonists, including Milt Caniff and Bill Mauldin, influenced Schulz.
- Charlie Brown and Snoopy were featured on the cover of *Life* magazine in 1967.
